## IMMIGRATION ACT

### (CHAPTER 191)

## IMMIGRATION (FEES) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 2015

The Minister, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 45 of the Immigration Act, makes the following Regulations —

#### 1. Citation.

These Regulations may be cited as the Immigration (Fees) (Amendment) Regulations, 2015.

#### 2. Amendment to Schedule to Sub. Leg. Vol. II, Ch. 191 – 36D.

The Schedule to the Immigration (Fees) Regulations is amended as follows —

- (a) in paragraph 2, by the deletion of the words “or a permit in any of the scales 9 to 11 hereunder” and the substitution of the words “or a permit in scale 9 hereunder”;
- (b) in paragraph 3 by —
  - (i) the deletion of the words “or a permit in any of the scales 9 to 11 hereunder” and the substitution of the words “or a permit in scale 9 hereunder”;
  - (ii) the deletion of the words “or prison overseer” and the substitution of the words “,or government officer”;
- (c) in paragraph 4, by the deletion of sub-paragraph (b) and the substitution of the following —

“(b) in scale 9 hereunder”;
- (d) in paragraph 5A, by the deletion of the words “or prison overseer” and the substitution of the words “, or government officer”;
- (e) the deletion of paragraph 7 and the substitution of the following —

“7. For a permanent residence certificate —

  - (a) for the spouse or surviving spouse  
of a Bahamian citizen falling  
within the provisions of

- section 14(1) of the Act.....\$ 250
- (b) for a widow who was previously endorsed on the certificate of her husband.....\$ 500;
- (c) in any other case.....\$5000
- (f) by the deletion of paragraph 8 and the substitution of the following —
  - “8. For a permanent residence certificate —
    - (a) with the right to engage in gainful employment for a person born outside The Bahamas to a married Bahamian mother or father.....\$ 500
    - (b) with the right to engage in gainful employment for a person born outside The Bahamas whose mother or father acquired citizenship by virtue of Article 3(2) of the Constitution.....\$ 250
    - (c) for a dependent child over the age of eighteen who was previously endorsed on the certificate of his mother or father.....\$ 500”;
- (g) by the insertion immediately after paragraph 21 of the the following new paragraphs —
  - “22. For a general worker permit for a person previously married to a Bahamian citizen and who has children of the marriage..... \$100
  - 23. For a resident belonger permit issued pursuant to section 30A of the Act to —
    - (a) a person born in The Bahamas to non-Bahamian parents who is entitled to apply for registration as a citizen of The Bahamas under Article 7 of the Constitution and who is residing permanently in The Bahamas at the time the application is made.....\$ 25
    - (b) a person born outside The Bahamas to a Bahamian mother who is married to a non-Bahamian father.....\$ 25
